Please read the following information concerning your utility service.

Utilities with the City of Oxford include water, sewer, refuse and recycling charges if you live within the Oxford City limits.

All new account sign-ups are charged a \$50 nonrefundable initiation fee

This fee will be charged on your first utility bill.

Utility bills are mailed the first working day of each month.

Payment is due on the 18th of the month. Visa & Mastercard accepted.

Your payment must reach our office by the due date in order to avoid any penalties. Once an account is in arrears it is considered delinquent and is subject to termination. Arrears are defined as outstanding charges from both the current month and previous months' billing. A delinquent bill indicating the arrearage and any applied penalties will be mailed the day after the current month's bill was due. To avoid termination, please pay the past due portion of your bill by the due date indicated on the bill.

Rumpke collects refuse under contract with the City of Oxford. All residential customers living inside the city limits will have their garbage collected once a week. The monthly charge for regular residential service is \$14.92 and is limited to ten (10) cans or items per week. Recycling is also included in this charge.

Oxford City Code 931.02 states all garbage is to be placed in covered, rodent-proof containers of a capacity not more than 32 gallons and not weighing more than 60 lbs. All containers must have tight fitting lids. Please do not place or leave containers at curbside more than 24 hours before or after pick up to prevent theft or possible fines.

Place your recyclables in the red, 14-gallon container that Rumpke supplies to residential customers for your use.

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 2921.13 (A)

- (A) No person shall knowingly make a false statement, or knowingly swear to affirm the trust of a false statement previously made, when any of the following applies:
 - (3) The statement is made with the purpose to mislead a public official in performing the public official's official function;
 - (8) The statement is in writing and is made with purpose to induce another to extend or bestow upon the offender any other valuable benefit or distinction, when the person to whom the statement is directed relies upon it to that person's detriment;
 - (9) The statement is made with purpose to commit or facilitate the commission of a theft offense;
 - (11) The statement is made on an account, form, record, stamp, label, or other writing that is required by law;
- (F) (1) Whoever violates division (A) (3), (A) (8) or (A) (11) of this section is guilty of falsification, a misdemeanor of the first degree; and
 - (2) Whoever violates division (A) (9) of this section is guilty of falsification in a theft offense. Except as otherwise provided in this division, falsification in a theft offense is a misdemeanor of the first degree. If the value of the property or services stolen is five hundred dollars or more and is less than five thousand dollars, falsification in a theft offense is a felony of the fifth degree.
