**Meeting Summary**

**Call to Order:** Billy Fitzgerald called the meeting to order at 2:40 PM>

**Introduction:**

**Approval of Agenda:** Members present voiced consent the agenda.

**OPD/MUPD Updates:** Stg. Varley reported that OPD was dealing with the same, normal issues as before. The recent tragic loss of a Miami student prompted the discussion about the "Good Samaritan Policy" and the role and responsibility of friends and bystanders. The important message of this policy to students was the safety of the fellow students. When in doubt, made sure to contact the appropriate agencies and let the care of your fellow students to those professionals. The caller would not be subject to any disciplinary action, unless interfering with public safety officer's business. It was critical to continue to educate the students about this policy, so the student could fully understand about the policy.

**Alcohol Taskforce Updates:** Nothing new to report since the Alcohol Coordinating Committee had been in recess during the summer session. More updates to come in the future.

**Party Registration:** Jung-Han Chen brought up the topic of party registration that the Off-Campus Partners Work Group had been working on. The idea was to create an on-line registration, administered by Miami, with the information about social hosting, local laws and regulations and other useful information to the Off-Campus students about having parties. After the completion of this on-line registration, there may be free or discounted water or snacks from local merchants.

More discussions about concerns and drawbacks, along with positive consequences that could come out from this registration took place among members. Dr. Curme advised that there was a subcommittee working on this and inputs from student would be critical to make the roll out of this program, fall of 2017, with the student buy in. There would be more updates from the subcommittee in the near future.
