ITEM 2
APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes of the January 11, 2018 Civil Rights Commission Meeting.

A. Lane Library Handicap Parking.

Mr. Elliott advised he spoke with the director of the Library, Joe Greenward who informed him that a complaint was filed with the Office of Civil Rights with the U.S. Department of Education regarding the handicap spaces being further away from the entrance than the low emission parking spaces. Mr. Greenward advised Mr. Elliott that the elimination of the low emission spaces satisfied the complaint and Mr. Elliott expressed his hope that the Library will find a way to relocate the handicap spaces to the location of the former low emission parking spaces.
