Meeting called to order at 9.31 AM.

New Business: Permit parking for Acorn Circle. The City started to receive complaints about parking from Acorn Circle residents after completion of the Verge apartment complex. A petition was distributed to residents and returned to the City. The City has completed a parking survey; the average occupancy rate was 43%. Angela supports a 24/7 permit zone. Uptown occupancy study: Lara and Angela presented their findings from the study. Highest occupancy is from 6-8 PM; lowest occupancy is overnight, due to the parking ban from 4-5.30 AM. Lara will work on another presentation on cost and hardware to help make revisions to the parking policy.

Transportation working group: Examined and evaluated options to provide connectivity from the OAT trail to uptown.
